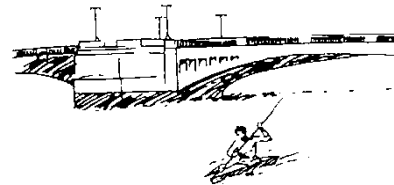

READING ASSESSMENT RACE Sunday 29-May-2016

Venue: Thameside Promenade

Thameside Promenade, Reading, south bank of the Thames, upstream of Caversham Bridge. Follow signs to Reading town centre, then signs for Caversham. Canoe Race signs will be seen near Caversham Bridge. **Please note: No parking available at RCC.**

Please make sure that you indicate clearly the category you are competing in as well as the division.

Juniors must be under the aged of 18 on 1st January of the race year

Veterans must be aged over 35 on 1st January of the race year

Rules

- The Race will be run in accordance with the rules in the Canoe Racing Handbook 2016
- Vertical number plates will be provided, lost numbers will be charged £5.00.
- This is a River Thames race: Cabin cruisers and other craft will be frequently encountered. RULES OF THE RIVER MUST BE OBSERVED.
- All entries must be received by Friday before the race otherwise a late entry fee will be charged.
- Entrants must have a valid BCU membership card on check in, failure to provide membership card means you will not be allowed to race.
- BCU cards or photocopies must be sent with entry.
- RCC and its nominated officials cannot be held responsible for any loss of life, limb or equipment however caused.
- Paddlers will be disqualified if they dispose of a disposable system outside the portage area (other than in a bin of course!)
- Reading Canoe Club and its nominated officials cannot be held responsible for any loss of life, injury or damage to equipment however caused.
