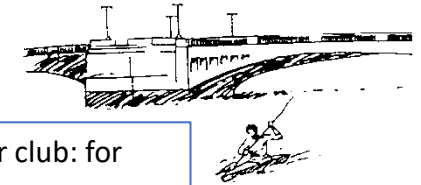
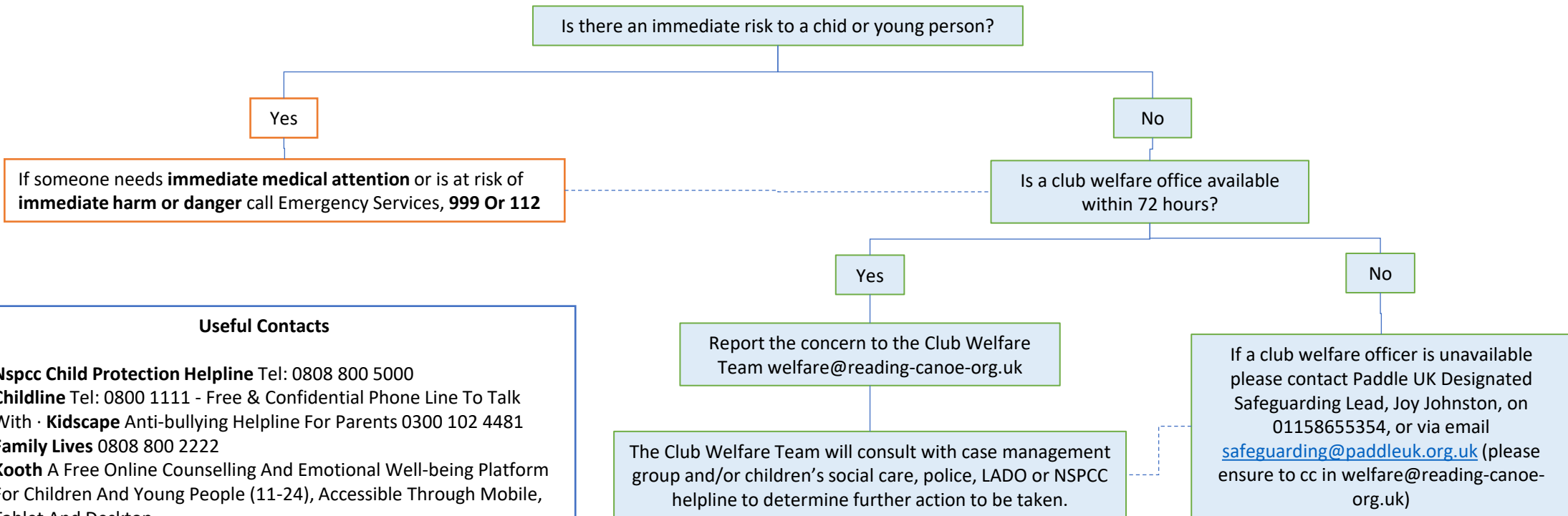


Reporting a Safeguarding and Protection Concern



This flowchart outlines the safeguarding reporting procedure to follow in the event of a concern arising about children or young people within our club: for example, an allegation about any club member's or volunteer's behaviour towards a child.

Notes: The terms 'child' and 'young person' describe any person under the age of 18. The term 'Local Authority Designated Officer' may be better known by the former acronym 'LADO'.
